## **ORDINANCE NO. 1046**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ATLANTIC, IOWA, BY AMENDING SECTION 151.04 SUBECTION 3: PLANTING RESTRICTIONS PROHIBITED TREES.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Atlantic, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section/Subsection 151.04(3) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Atlantic Iowa, repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

3. Prohibited Trees. No person shall plant the following tree species in the road right-of-way nor in City parks: cotton bearing poplar trees, white poplar, cottonwood, boxelder, willow, evergreen, freeman/hybrid maple (acer x freemanii autumn blaze, armstrong, marmo, and sienna glen are frequently seen cultivars), amur maple, norway maple, silver maple ash, blue spruce, callery/ornamental pear, ornamental cherry, mulberry, golden raintree, tree of heaven, black locust, siberian elm, russian olive, and salt cedar

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
